4) Old Business

a. Dues for 2015-2016

- Dave has gotten a lot of great suggestions of how to move the site. It doesn't look like it will be overly expensive and may be able to get additional services for our conference and the chapter and increased reliability
- New cabinet will need to deal with this
- Dave has backed up the site so far in case it goes away without us knowing. The database stuff has not all necessarily been backed-up

d. Hotel contract

- Need to find a new location or stick with our current location, the Courtyard has been very good to us
- Hotel team will be looking into this

- Members have suggested we try to get this done this fall and not wait until the spring
- Will be looking around hotels in Ames, though some conference attendees like the conference to be close to downtown Des Moines
- Team can contact Des Moines chamber of commerce to help get bids for hotels

5) New Business

a. 20th Annual Severe Storms and Doppler Radar Conference

- March 31st – April 2nd, 2016 – Courtyard by Marriott, Ankeny, IA
- Team updates

Agenda Team

- Dr. Uccellini has changed his schedule so that he will be the banquet speaker for our conference, but he will need to leave first thing Friday morning
- Team has a selection of events to choose from this year and will begin voting and narrowing down events very soon
 - o Anniversary of the Andover outbreak, SC flooding
- Do we want to bring big name people in this year, not just weather events since it's our 20th Anniversary conference?
 - o Tom Skilling
 - o The Weather Channel
 - Chris now has an "in" with a friend at TWC which may help our odds of getting a speaker. We have not had luck in the past when trying
- If we had a "blank check" what would the students like to see? Nice that a large number of the team members are students to help provide input in this regard since a large number of our attendees are students
- Do we want to set a budget for the agenda team to spend on bringing in speakers this year?
 - o It's harder to spend a lot of money this year because a lot of the events this year are close to us in Iowa, so we may be able to have more speakers at about the same cost
 - o Dave encourages us to go big this year as it's the 20th Anniversary
 - o Last year we spent \$3109.8 in travel but actual costs may have been closer to \$3300 due one of our speakers not being paid for by us
 - o In the past we got \$2000 from the NWS central region, but have not gotten this money for several years due to budget issues with the NWS
 - o *Future action needed to decide on a budget (or not) for the agenda/travel teams*
- If we have more abstracts submitted would we expand the conference time?
 - o We have not had this problem in the past
 - o Expanding the conference time or running two rooms would increase costs to the chapter

Electronics Team

- Have talked about recording the presentations differently, at UnityPoint Willard has been using GoTo Meeting or another streaming source to the registration table (so they don't miss the speakers) and this could also double as a recording source
 - o TeamView may also be possible to share screens with the registration desk
 - o This would also eliminate needing to hook into the hotel sound system

- Team will be looking into this for this conference year

Scholarship Team

- Proposal to increase scholarship amounts for the 20th anniversary, see discussion further on in notes (section c)

b. Chapter of the Year application

- Elise Schultz is a possible person to nominate us and Bill feels she would be willing to do so
- We will need to contact her

c. Pam Daale Scholarship increase request (Donavon)

- Team proposes to stay the same on the Pam Daale scholarship (\$1500 from the chapter plus any additional from WeatherCall) plus conference registration and travel funds
- Proposal to add \$500 to the scholarship budget to be spent either in addition to the Pam Daale scholarship OR as a second place scholarship, which would NOT require attendance to the conference for this second place winner
- Tim Samaras awards were \$200 and \$150 last year and could be boosted as part of the 20th anniversary, but can wait on this a bit to decide
- Motion to increase the budget to \$2250 from \$1750 for this year
 - Motioned by Rod, Second by Kevin.
 - **Voted and approved**

6) Treasurers report

- We have been over \$20000 since Jim has been treasurer and so Jim assures us we can spend extra money this year
